### OF ORCHESTRAL MUSIC

When I was 7 or 8, my class went to the Toronto Symphony Orchestra where they played the Harry Potter score and Star Wars. I felt like my whole body was electrified. I was on the complete edge of my seat and the music just swelled around me.

### **HOW DID YOU FIND PGSO?**

It's unusual to have a symphony in a city of about 80,000 people. I came to check out campus and drove by their sign on a building. Live music is really important to me. It blew me away and made me feel better about moving here.

### WHO HAS A "PGSO SIDE"?

Me! I just discovered it, and I'm 25 years old.

And so many others. They just don't know they like it... yet.

### WHY IS PGSO SO GREAT?

It's very personable. When I went, they weren't holding the concert in a traditional space. It made it more intimate. And when I walked in the door, people were genuinely excited that I was there.

### **LOVES PGSO BECAUSE**

In the winter months, there isn't a lot to do indoors and it gets dark early, but PGSO is special. They somehow bring the smaller city vibe into the symphony experience. It's affordable for a student and the music is spectacular. They talk about the pieces a bit before playing them, too. You can see they want to try different things. I like that they sometimes bring in different musicians.

### **LOVES PRINCE GEORGE BECAUSE**

When I moved here in 2020, I was excited because in a mid-sized community, you don't often have great access to the arts. It's really special and it's such an important part of the community. If I worked in an industry that thrived here, PGSO would be a huge reason for why I'd potentially stay.

Highly acclaimed for his intensity and spontaneity, Hall has appeared with many of today's leading ensembles, including the Houston Symphony, the Toronto Symphony, the Vancouver Symphony, the Louisiana Philharmonic, the Pacific Symphony, the Civic Orchestra of Chicago, Symphoria, the Orquesta Sinfónica Nacional de Costa Rica, the Winnipeg Symphony, the Toledo Symphony, the Windsor Symphony, the Manitoba Chamber Orchestra, the Great Falls Symphony, the Bozeman Symphony, the Northeastern Pennsylvania Philharmonic, Groundswell New Music Ensemble, and the Havant Symphony in the UK, as well as a return to the Tucson Symphony, with whom he has a special relationship and has been a frequent guest conductor in multiple concert series over the past nine seasons. Hall also works regularly with the Space Coast Symphony in Florida, where he is the newly appointed Principal Guest Conductor.

Through his dad (Bill Wood) who was one heck of a trumpet player and first to play the Last Post as a soloist during the National Remembrance Day ceremony in Ottawa.

### **DISCOVERED TUBA**

My Dad repaired instruments on the side. He brought home a tuba one day and said, "Have a blow on this." I got this great big sound out of it.

### WHO HAS A PGSO SIDE?

I don't think they know who they are yet, if they haven't been exposed to it.
I didn't know I liked shrimp until I tried it. You need to take a bite.

### WHY IS PGSO SO GREAT?

You have a much better chance of seeing someone you know on stage. Without fail I get an email on Monday saying, 'I had no idea you play tuba.' If you go and hang out in the foyer, you can get into some really cool conversations.

### **LOVES PRINCE GEORGE BECAUSE**

The vibe downtown has cool restaurants and boutique shops. Plus, I can go to Home Depot or Costco and then the symphony or the theatre at night. It's an outdoor playground, there's great golf, and my commute to work is 3 minutes.

### **LOVES PGSO BECAUSE**

The friendships with my fellow musicians, we go for beers together. PGSO is one of the great selling features that helps recruit all kinds of people to move here. I think sometimes it gets taken for granted that it's always going to be around.

### **SPOTLIGHT MOMENTS**

- Having the chance to perform on stage with my Dad when I was only 18.
- I've slept in my tuba case (missed the last bus home from University, spent the night in the music building and the case was my sleeping bag).
- My dad once recorded our answering machine with me playing the A&W Root Bear song in the background.
- I did an interview on an Ottawa radio (rock) station for International Tuba Day. The hosts made me play live with a pre-recorded track. No notice, no practice!
